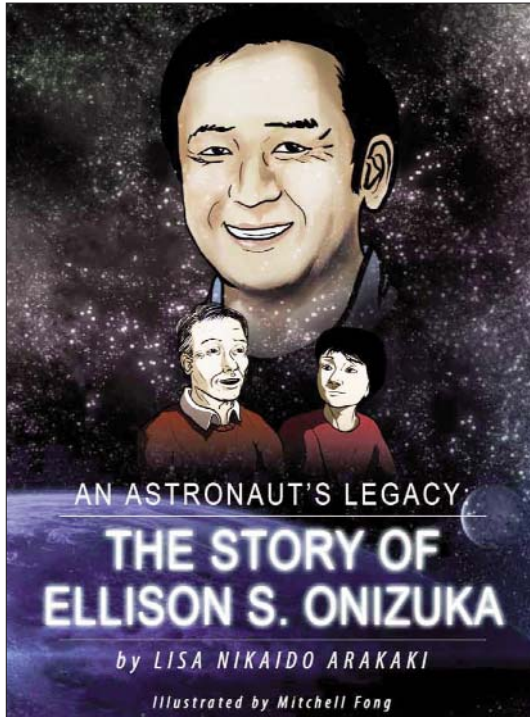


# THE STORY OF ELLISON S. ONIZUKA

It's been 26 years since the space shuttle Challenger disaster.
